
Annual Earnings






Critical Needs for Bachelor's Degrees

Education Needs Index for South Carolina




Level of Education Need




The need for an increase in bachelor degrees to meet projected job market demands is considered "most critical" or "critical" across South Carolina.


2013-2014 Palmetto College Online by the Numbers

- 241 degrees conferred in Year 1 (Fall 2013-Fall 2014)




Growth rate projected at 25% to 50% in 2014-2015:
