Procedures for Motions

Please use the <u>Senate-approved template</u> for all motions affecting the *Palmetto College Campuses Faculty Manual*. Please include the original language from the *Faculty Manual* and use the document reviewing function of Microsoft Word to track changes so that insertions and deletions are readily apparent. Motions not affecting the *Manual* may also be presented in the template, which may be modified as needed.

Motions coming from committee require no second; motions from individuals require a second to be considered on the Senate floor. Once the motion has been made and seconded if necessary, the standing committee chair or the individual proposing the motion should please follow the instructions below to have the motion posted on the Palmetto College Campuses Faculty Senate website. Please be sure to send the final version of the motion, if it was amended on the Senate floor after presentation.

Any motion ruled substantive by the Chair of the Palmetto College Campuses Faculty Senate must be published on the Palmetto College Campuses Faculty Senate web page within ten business days of its introduction, or else it shall expire.
