Important Notes to Course Offerings (Revised as of 09/30//08)

1. This schedule includes required courses and some approved electives for the BMA and TAX tracks and the semester(s) and times (if available) that they will be offered. Because many of the courses are offered only one time each year, please plan your schedule accordingly. Also refer to MASTER OF ACCOUNTANCY CURRICULUM – SUMMER 2008 – SPRING 2009.
2. All course offerings are contingent upon sufficient enrollment.
3. If you wish to take a graduate elective other than one listed on this Course Offerings sheet, you must get it pre-approved by Jimmy Burkett. Prior to meeting with Jimmy, you should get a syllabus for the course and/or talk to the instructor to gather some information about the course.
4. Instructors of 500 level courses will require work in addition to that which is assigned to undergraduate students.
5. PMBA course numbers are followed by a T and have different starting and ending dates than other courses. In addition to the night classes, there are several required Saturday meetings. If you are interested in taking a PMBA course, please refer to the master schedule of classes. The night classes are broadcast to various sites around the campus and the state. If you wish to take the course at a site other than the Columbia Campus, I must register you in the class and you will need to contact the site coordinator to make sure that viewing has been set up for the site. *******Students who complete their program of study in PMBA Summer II may not receive their degrees until December graduation.*******
6. The days and times shown on this schedule may change. Check the master schedule for each semester before registering. After registering request list schedule to verify. Check your schedule again a couple of days before the semester starts.
7. The Spring 2009 accounting course and the non-accounting elective course schedules are set. The spring 2009 non-accounting electives course schedules are fairly firm. Use the summer the 2008 schedule in planning for summer of 2009. As mentioned in 6 above there may be some future changes to this schedule. The summer 2009 PMBA schedule has not been set. **If you plan to graduate in August, do not wait until summer to take a required class.**
8. The content of the MGSC Information Systems courses changes very rapidly and in some cases overlaps the Accounting Information System courses. If you wish to take one of these courses you may want to talk to the instructor, get a recent syllabus and talk to one of our Accounting Systems instructors (Dr. Leitch or Dr. Tuttle).
9. Students who have had two undergraduate business law courses generally cannot take ACCT 504 for graduate credit. However, if there is room in the class, you may check with the instructor and sit in on the course as a review of CPA Exam Law.
10. A curriculum change has removed ACCT 733 Accounting Theory as a required course in the BMA Track. The BMA track now requires 0 - 18 hours of electives and at least one of the approved electives be a 700-level course. In the past students have really liked this class and it is a very good elective for students in either track.
