How did our healthcare system get to this point? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● A series of historical accidents; lack of planning ● 20th Century: Public Hospital systems, tuberculous outbreak ● WWII: Companies paid employees through health benefits to compensate for wage cuts ● Johnson Administration: Medicaid & Medicare ● Affordable Care Act 	1:51
What is HTA doing to change the current state of healthcare? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Cohort of 46 American companies ● Coordinate spending on healthcare and arrange it in a way that encourages top performers (i.e. most effective care) ● Rank providers: identify who is better <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Effective providers can help people live longer, healthier lives ○ Will cost more in the short-term, but the long-term matters most 	3:42
What challenges do you face in making HTA as effective as possible? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Disruption: shaking-up the business model ● Resistance from healthcare providers 	6:11
What role does data analytics play in achieving HTA's goal? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Who is most likely to develop X disease? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Build a database that can assist with figuring this out ● Early detection/intervention can... <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Prevent health problems from worsening ○ Help individuals find better methods of care 	7:32
What role does the government play? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Guard individual's privacy and confidentiality (i.e. family medical facts) ● De-identification via aggregate data; the larger the sample size, the more accurate the data 	9:25
What does the future of HTA look like? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● HTA should trigger a marketplace of competition, where healthcare buyers challenge healthcare providers to compete in a better way 	10:35
