Between Fallers and Non-Fallers in People Living with Multiple
Sclerosis: A Pilot Study

This study is aimed at identifying aspects of mobility that may be indicative of fall risk among people living with MS.

<u>Eligibility Criteria:</u> Individuals are eligible if diagnosed with MS, are a community-dwelling adult (>18 years old), able to follow commands, can walk at least 20 feet with or without the aid of a person or an assistive device, and able to provide consent.

Individuals are ineligible if not diagnosed with MS, have severe cognitive impairments, unable to walk even with assistance.

Time Commitment: 1 in-person session, approximately 1 hour
